



Admissions Requirements - ADN Program

NursingCAS Application

Required Entrance Exam:

ATI TEAS is the required entrance exam for all applicants to the ADN program. Applicants must achieve a **55** or higher on their overall score. ATI TEAS testing is available at Centra College and remotely via ATI at <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/register>. The TEAS test is a comprehensive exam that tests on four different subject areas, so thorough preparation is crucial. The TEAS Score requirement may be waived if you have one year of clinical working experience as an LPN within two years of the application deadline.

Required Official, final High School Transcripts/GED:

A conferred high school diploma or a completed GED is required.

Completion of Required Pre-requisite Courses:

- *BIO 141: Anatomy & Physiology I (4 cr hrs)
- *BIO 142: Anatomy & Physiology II (4 cr hrs)
- *HLT 143: Medical Terminology (3 cr hrs)
- **PSY 230: Developmental Psychology (3 cr hrs)
- *HLT 230: Principles of Nutrition (3 cr hrs)
- *PSY 200+ Elective (3 3cr hrs)

All prerequisites must be completed with a grade of “C” or higher, and the pre-req GPA minimum is a **2.7** to be considered for admission.

*Health and Science pre-req and co-req courses must be no more than 10 years old to transfer.

** PSY 230 cannot fulfill the PSY 200 elective requirement. All students will need to complete two psychology courses as degree requirements.

Your completed online application, High School transcripts, College Transcripts, and TEAS scores must be submitted on or before the application deadline.
