



Admissions Requirements - PN Program

NursingCAS Application

Required Entrance Exam:

ATI TEAS is the required entrance exam for all applicants to the PN program. Applicants must achieve a 50 or higher on their overall score. ATI TEAS testing is available at Centra College and remotely via ATI at <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/register>. The TEAS test is a comprehensive exam that tests on four different subject areas, so thorough preparation is crucial.

Required Official, final High School Transcripts/GED:

A conferred high school diploma or a completed GED is required.

Your completed online application, High School transcripts, and TEAS scores must be submitted on or before the application deadline.

Meeting minimum admissions requirements does not guarantee admission.

1st Semester courses listed below must be completed in the first semester of the PN program or prior to admission to be considered to start the 2nd Semester Courses

A minimum GPA of **2.5** is required in the first semester PN courses. Please see the curriculum guide for more information.

- *BIO 145: Human Anatomy and Physiology for the Health Sciences (4 cr hrs) *or*
BIO 142: Human Anatomy and Physiology II (4 cr hrs)
- *HLT 143: Medical Terminology I (3 cr hrs)
- *PSY 230: Developmental Psychology (3 cr hrs)
- ENG 111: College Composition I (3 cr hrs)
- SDV 110: Principles of Nursing Success (1 cr hr) - This course will only be available to take through Centra College

The above health sciences courses, must have been completed within the last 10 years.
